SMALL ENGINES GIVING YOU BIG PROBLEMS?

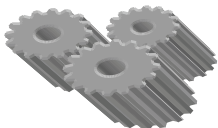
Two thoughts.....

Maintenance and coaching. Through the years we've found that at least 90% of the downtime associated with small engines (and equipment in general) comes from either a lack of routine maintenance such as oil and filter changes or a lack of training in

the proper care of the engines. Some important tips.....

- Turn the fuel off when transporting.
- Change the oil every 50-100 hours.
- Check the air filter monthly or more often in dusty conditions.

- Take note of the pull cord condition and get it replaced when it looks frayed rather than after it breaks.
- Change the fuel filter and spark plug every six months or after each busy season.
