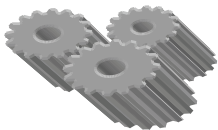

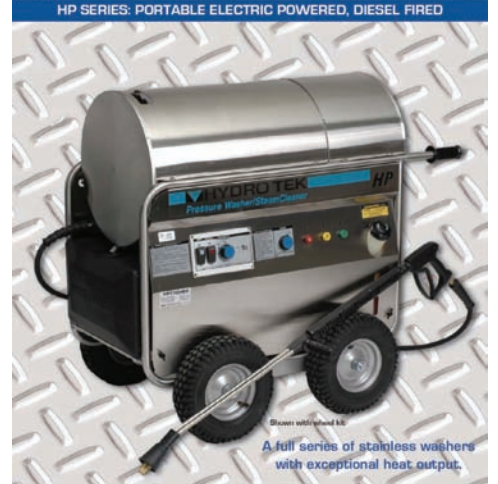

## PARKING IT FOR THE WINTER?

Lawn mowers, rototillers, edger's— just a few of the things that are going to be used much less over the next several months. Our opinion of the best storage practices for small engines are as follows:

- Full tank of treated fuel, run long enough to get treated
- fuel into the motor, about 2 minutes should do it.
- Batteries either disconnected or hooked up to a battery maintainer.
- Make sure the oil level is correct. If you really want to care for it, start it or at least
- turn it over (pull the cord through a few times if it's a manual start) once a month. This will redistribute the oil helping prevent rust.
- Also, check tire pressure monthly, antifreeze your water pumps, store paint sprayers with mineral spirits.

- 10 Tablespoons Butter
- 1 Cup Sugar
- 1/4 Teaspoon Vanilla
- 2 Tablespoon Cocoa Powder
- 4 Cups "Quick Oats"
- ~ 1/2 Cup Cold Water
